Dear GPS Community,

The State of Arizona, through the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) notified all school districts in the state that they would be conducting random lead screening tests of drinking water in public schools. All of our schools in GPS were included in this random testing over the past few weeks. Today we received the results for 25 of our schools. When I receive the results for the remainder of our schools, I will share those results with you as well.

I am pleased to report that the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has shared that the lead screening results for drinking water samples collected at the following schools were less than the screening level:
