Attendance Policy

- **FINALS:** Finals will be held during the week of June 25th. Students must be present for finals. No early/late finals will be allowed. Please plan accordingly.
- **ATHLETES:** If you have a sports camp scheduled in June, we recommend you consider taking your courses through GPS Global Academy Online Learning.
- Students withdrawing after two (2) weeks will receive a WF on their transcript. **There are no exceptions to this rule. Keep this policy in mind when scheduling other summer activities. Those with scheduling conflicts might consider GPS Global Academy Online Learning Program as an alternative.**
- Due to the fast-paced, accelerated courses offered in summer school, maximum attendance is essential for student success.
- A student is permitted two (2) absences during a summer school session. Automatic withdrawal will be processed on the third (3rd) absence and all monies paid will be forfeited. Note: Two (2) summer school absences equal ten (10) semester absences during the regular school year.
- Punctuality is important to student success. Three (3) tardies are equal to one (1) absence. Students are tardy up to ten (10) minutes after class begins. After ten (10) minutes, students are considered absent.
- Report absences to the Summer School Office at 480-545-2555.
- Tardy students must report to the Summer School Office prior to attending class.
