The district gifted delivery model provides K-3 gifted cluster classrooms, accelerated math in 4-6 grades and ELA instruction and enrichment in 6th grade. Additional information specific to 20-21 delivery models is below:



Gifted students will be in Gifted Cluster Classrooms in grades K-6. Gifted services will continue with accelerated 4th-6th grade math and 6th grade ELA instruction/enrichment with their campus gifted teacher. Gifted students in grades other than 4th-6th may receive additional services depending on their school's gifted model.

Students who participate in Towne Meadow and Highland Jr. High self-contained programs will be assigned to a math class that is appropriate for them.
