³ Students that have not taken a foreign language class at the junior high school can take Spanish I freshman year and GHS pre-IB Spanish II their sophomore year. Students can also take *ab-initio* Mandarin their junior year with no prior knowledge.

⁴ IB History of the Americas meets the ABOR American/Arizona History requirement.

⁵ Students must complete mathematics through Algebra II to be eligible for IB math Applications junior year.
