No teacher, elective class, or lunch hour changes will be made. No level changes can be made until after the first 4 ½ weeks of the semester. ## **GHS PARKING PERMIT APPLICATIONS**

Complete the 2023-2024 Gilbert High School Parking Permit Rules and Regulations form online by clicking: [GHS Parking Permit Application](#)

The application must be filled out in its entirety, and acknowledged both by parent/guardian and student.

Parking Permits are \$60 for the year and payment must be made prior to receiving a parking hanger. Payment for parking permits may be made online starting July 5<sup>th</sup> at: [GPS Parent Portal](#)

Seniors and Juniors: Remember to bring your current AZ Driver's License to the GHS Bookstore during your designated Bookstore Day to pick up your parking hanger. If you are unable to make your designated day and time, you can bring your current AZ Driver's License during the second week of school to the GHS Bookstore to receive your 23-24 GHS parking hanger.

## **BOOKSTORE DAYS SCHEDULE**

All GHS Students must attend their assigned bookstore day below in order to obtain their GHS ID Card. ID cards are required for the first day of school. Paid parking hangers will also be available for pickup for Juniors and Seniors during their assigned time.

**Friday, July 14, 2023** - Seniors and Juniors only - 8:00AM - 10:30AM & 12:00PM - 2:00PM.

**Monday, July 17, 2023** - Sophomores, Freshmen & GAMS only - 8:00AM - 10:30AM & 12:00PM - 2:00PM.

**Tuesday, July 18, 2023** - All grades - 8:00AM - 10:30AM & 12:00PM - 2:00PM.

**Friday, July 21, 2023** - All grades Make-up day - 8:00AM - 10:30AM & 12:00PM - 2:00PM.

## **STUDENT ID CARDS**

All students must wear their GHS issued ID card while on campus at all times on a lanyard or badge clip. IDs must be clearly visible. No decorative stickers or defacing of any type are allowed on ID cards.

Any student who has forgotten their ID must report to the GHS Bookstore or GHS Reception to obtain a temporary ID sticker for the day. Students will be assessed a \$1 fine each time a temporary ID sticker is issued. Temporary IDs are only valid for the day they are issued.

Any student who has lost their permanent ID must report to the GHS Bookstore for a replacement permanent ID card. Students will be assessed a \$5 fine each time a new permanent ID card is issued.

Any student found wearing an ID which does not belong to them or an ID from a previous school year will be referred to their grade level administrator.

Fines accrued must be paid through the [GPS Parent Portal](#) or in person at the GHS Bookstore.

## **PAYMENTS FOR FEES AND ADDITIONAL PURCHASES**

To make a payment for your student at GHS, please follow online payment directions to ensure your student's fees are paid correctly. Unpaid fees could result in a student being removed from the class(es). All fees and purchases must also be paid in full – no partial payments. Use the instructions below to navigate to the GHS Bookstore website for online payments. **The portal will be open to accept payments for parking permits starting July 5<sup>th</sup>. The portal will be open to accept payments for all other needs (course fees, yearbooks, etc.) on July 10<sup>th</sup>.**

### **Cash Payments:**

Cash payments are accepted in person at the GHS Bookstore.

### **Online purchases are as follows:**

- Class Fees (see page 8)
- Parking Permit \$60
- Yearbooks \$75/\$80 (personalized nameplate)
- PE Uniform \$20 (required for PE)
- Chromebook Device Protection Plan \$25

Uniforms will be distributed by the PE teachers to students during the first few weeks of school. Please **print your receipt** so your student can provide it to the PE teacher as proof of payment.

All returning GHS 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students have a Chromebook. Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students or students new to GPS will receive a Chromebook per our distribution schedule at the start of our school year. Parents have the option to enroll in the district's device protection plan during the first month of school for \$25 per year via the parent portal. This will cover repairs which otherwise could cost up to \$200.

## **REMINDER: GILBERT HIGH SCHOOL IS A CLOSED CAMPUS**

Per Gilbert Public School (GPS) Policy JHCA, **all GPS schools are closed campuses**. Students are to remain on campus during the school day, including lunch, unless they are signed out by a parent/guardian in person or have approved release time. Students found to have been off campus during school hours may be subject to a search by school personnel and face disciplinary consequences including in-school suspension.

Gilbert High School does not accept food deliveries from delivery services such as DoorDash, Uber Eats, or from restaurants. Students may purchase lunch from the school cafeteria or bring their own lunch from home. See the link below for information about cafeteria services.

### **Information for Prospective Athletes**

# Gilbert Public Schools

## Dress Code Expectations

Gilbert Public Schools supports dress standards that ignite a culture of learning and well-being. Students are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate for the school day or for any school-sponsored event. Dress standards will be applied consistently and enforcement of these standards will minimize the loss of educational time.

### General requirements

- Student ID Badges are required to be worn and visible.
- Clothing must include a top and a bottom (such as pants, skirt, shorts or the equivalent), or a one-piece outfit (such as a dress or jumpsuit).
- Clothing must cover all private body parts and must not be see-through.
- Tops and one-piece outfits must be secured with material at the shoulders or neck.
- Clothing may not cover a student's face to the extent that the student is not identifiable (except clothing worn for health and safety, medical, or religious purposes).
- Footwear such as shoes, sandals or boots shall be worn in the school buildings at all times, and must be both safe and non-destructive to school property.
- All headwear must allow the face to be visible and not interfere with the line of sight to any student or staff (except clothing/headwear worn for health and safety, medical or religious purposes).

### Prohibited apparel and items

Students are not permitted to wear clothing, jewelry, or personal items that:

- Substantially disrupt the learning process
- Contribute to a hostile or intimidating environment
- Advocate, promote, or communicate
  - Violence or acts of terror
  - Criminal activity
  - Pornography or sexual references
  - Use of drugs or alcohol
  - Profanity
- Use or depict hate speech or symbols
- Threaten the health or safety of any other student or staff member
