ELA Targets

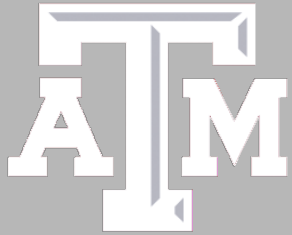
READING

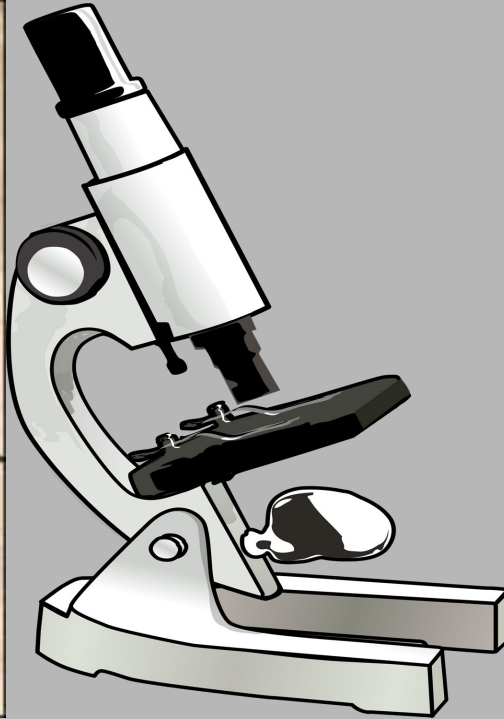
Math Targets

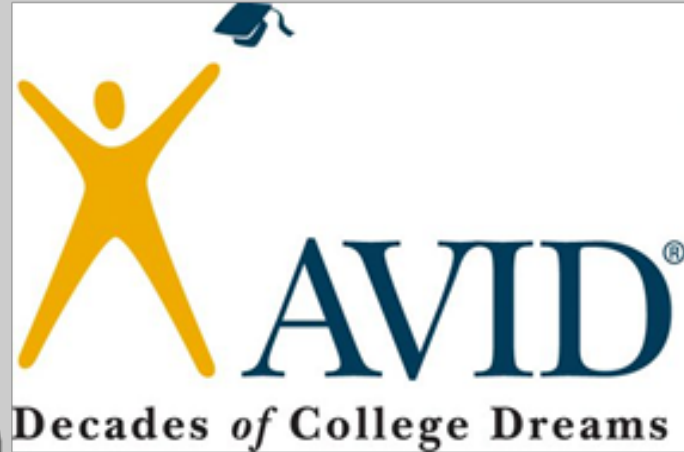
