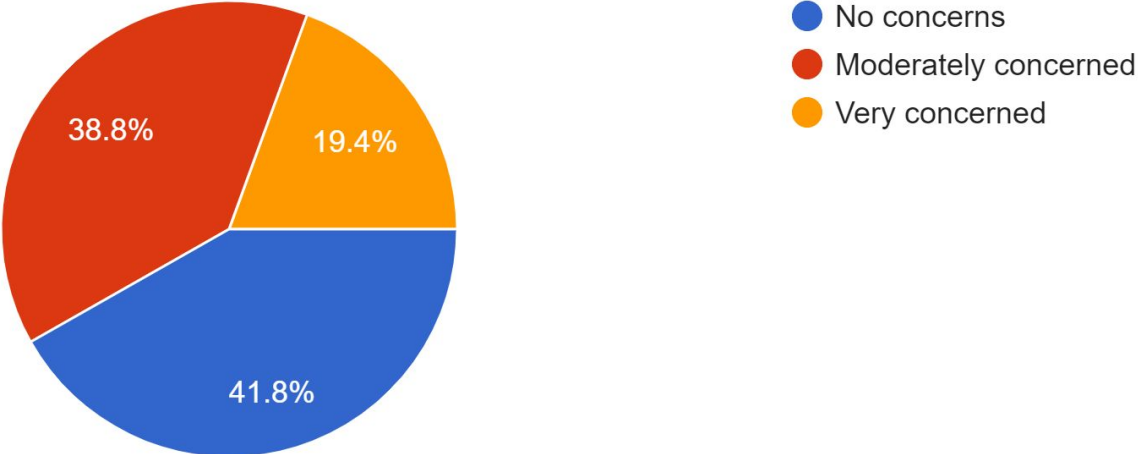
Return to School Survey

Summary

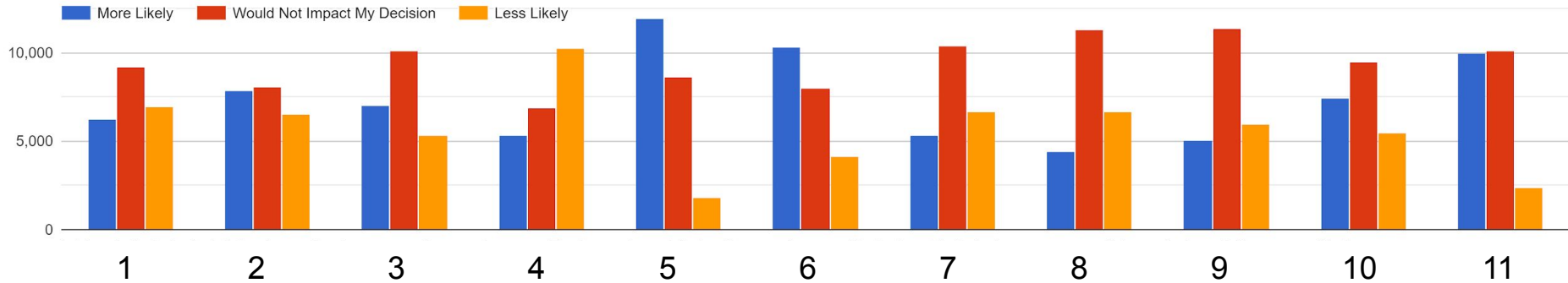
- Sent to all parents Monday June 1st via email (41,000)
- Reminder sent to all parents June 3rd via email
- Parents asked to complete one survey per student
- Total responses received = 22,405
- 42% no concerns about returning to school in August
- 39% moderate concerns about returning to school in August
- 19% very concerned about returning to school in August
- Top measures - Health screenings for employees and students
- Preferred teaching model - Students attend school full time (67%)

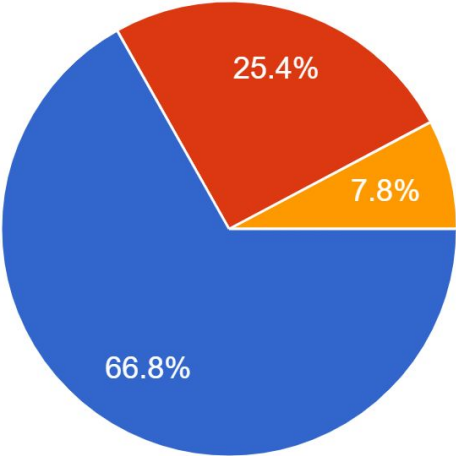
The district is exploring measures that might be put in place before opening schools for the new school year. If the following measures are in place, would you be more or less likely to send your child to school?

5. Employees have daily health screenings
6. Students have daily health screenings

8. Recess is modified
9. Extra-curricular activities are modified
10. Use of common areas is limited
11. Limit number of volunteers and visitors on campus

Based on your current family situation and personal concerns about safety and health, if you could choose a learning model for your child next school year, would you choose:

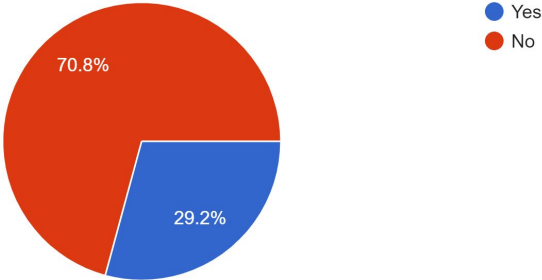

- Online instruction from home utilizing Gilbert Public Schools Global Academy curriculum and teachers.

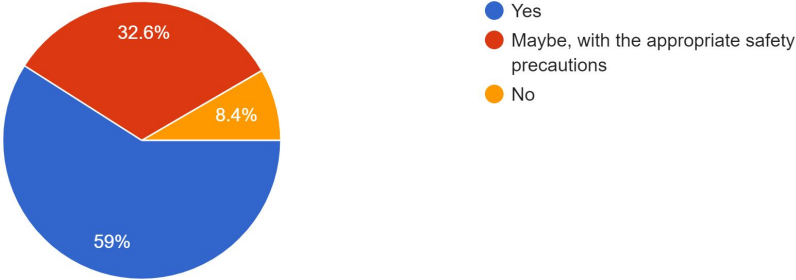
Does your child ride a bus to or from school?
