Unified PE is a physical education course that offers opportunities for special needs students and general education students to participate together as a team. It is a co-ed class where boys and girls are matched across grade levels to benefit the needs of all students. Students will receive one elective credit for the year in this course. Each day every student is expected to dress out, arrive on time, and will follow a Physical Education curriculum that allows all skill levels to succeed. Students will work cooperatively with each other on improving skills, understanding rules, and learning how to work effectively as a team. Games and activities are modified to match abilities, yet are still challenging enough to improve skills. Students will participate in general P.E. activities, such as badminton, soccer, football and volleyball, but in a modified setting.
