

## **Family and Community Engagement**

Students are more successful when schools, families and communities work together. Here at Oak Tree, we hope to create an environment where family engagement is an integral part of our students' education. The Oak Tree Elementary Title I program will use the following engagement opportunities:

- A **Title I Annual Parent Meeting** will be held (during Open House) to explain and discuss our School-wide Title I Program.
- A **School Curriculum Night/Night of Expectations** will be held near the beginning of the school year to inform parents of the Arizona Standards and Assessments.
- Title I Family Engagement events will be held throughout the year. Families will learn how to implement intentional "linked to learning" strategies that empower them to support learning at home. For example; Summer Library Program, Family Math and Reading Events, and PTO Events.
- Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held each year with flexible scheduling to discuss your student's progress and ways you can work together with the teacher to help your child reach their goals. Parents are welcomed to request a second conference later in the school year.
- **Report Cards** are available to view quarterly. Parents are encouraged to look up their student's grades on Infinite Campus regularly.
- Parents are welcome to **Contact Teachers** through school email and/or phone to discuss their child's success at school.
- School Newsletter/Updates will be sent out every Friday afternoon offering timely information and dates regarding school activities.
- Families are invited to **Volunteer** on PTO committees and around the school in different capacities, including school festivities, book fairs, and classroom activities.
- Title I Math and Reading Specialists will provide small group instruction based on student need.
- Partners in Learning Compacts will be signed by all students, their parents(guardians), and the Oak Tree Staff.
- Oak Tree Elementary parents and staff will participate in a **Title I Program Review**. Parents will be able to provide input through an online survey in regard to Family and Community Engagement events prior to the review.
