<b>7th Grade Electives</b>	
<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>JBMI710</p> <p>1 Semester</p> <p>Duo with Computer Coding</p> <p>(See Computer Coding video)</p> <p>Art one semester paired with Coding one semester.</p>	<p>This course is a study of various media and techniques used in art today. Two dimensional art is taught with an emphasis on creativity and an understanding of processes. Students may enter their artwork in the school's spring exhibit. One semester.</p> <p><a href="#">Art Video</a></p>
<p><b>Beginning Band 7 / 8</b></p> <p>JMU950</p> <p>1 Year</p>	<p>This course is a study of the basic elements of music tonal production and skill development. The major topics covered in this class will be Band Method I and concert preparation. This is for students interested in learning to play a band instrument for the first time or learning a new instrument. Some students enrolled in Beginning Band will continue their course of study in Band 7 or Band 8 second semester.</p> <p><b>***RESTRICTED INSTRUMENTATION</b></p> <p><i>Students may choose from Clarinet, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone, or Tuba. <p><b>Band 7*</b></p>	<p>This course is a study of basic fundamental technical development and large ensemble performance. The major</p>

Other features of this course are participation in school assembly programs and evening concerts. <p><b>Boys Choir 7/8</b></p> <p>JMU900</p> <p>1 year</p>	<p>This course is a study of beginning and intermediate music concepts: music reading skills with emphasis on solfege, vocal technique with focus on the boy's changing voice, and performance skills. No previous experience is required, and students will not be required to sing alone. The purpose of this course is to encourage students to have fun while studying different types of music, including traditional, musical theater, jazz, and popular styles, as well as music in foreign languages.</p> <p><a href="#">Choir Video</a></p>
<p><b>Family and Consumer Science (FACS)</b></p> <p>JBMI740</p> <p>1 Semester</p> <p>Duo with Industrial Tech</p> <p>(See Industrial Tech 7 video)</p> <p>FACS one semester paired with Ind. Tech one semester.</p>	<p>This course is an introduction to Family and Consumer Science. This class introduces kitchen safety, sanitation, understanding recipes, and basic cooking methods. Other areas of study may include childcare, career introductions, hand-sewing techniques and cooperative learning. One semester.</p> <p><a href="#">FACS 7 Video</a></p>
<p><b>Girls Choir 7</b></p> <p>JMU700</p> <p>1 year</p>	<p>This course is a study of beginning music concepts: music reading skills with emphasis on solfege, vocal technique, and performance skills. <p><b>Computer Coding</b> JBMI710 1 Semester</p> <p>Duo with Art  (see Art video)</p> <p>Coding one semester paired with Art one semester.</p>	<p>This course is an introduction to computer science with an emphasis on Coding. Through problem solving and project based learning, students will explore a variety of programming systems and languages to create interactive applications. <p><b>Drama 1</b> JCDR800 1 Year</p>	<p>This course is a study of the various aspects of the theatre. Major topics will include acting, movement, stage vocabulary, and oral speaking. Units of study will include pantomime, creative dramatics, monologues, scene work, oral interpretation, impromptu speaking, readers' theatre, variety show, and one act plays.</p> <p><a href="#">Drama Video</a></p>
<p><b>Industrial Technology 7</b> JBMI740 1 semester</p> <p>Duo with FACS  (See FACS video)</p> <p>FACS one semester paired with Ind. Tech one semester.</p>	<p>This course is designed to teach the basics in graphic communication, construction, manufacturing, and communication using problem solving, life management, and academic skills. <p><b>Leadership Development 7/8</b></p> <p>1 Year</p>	<p>This course will emphasize leadership skills. A major part of the course will be performing the duties of Student Council.</p> <p><b>*Prerequisite: Completed Application and teacher recommendations. <p><b>Orchestra 7*</b></p> <p>JMU730</p> <p>1 Year</p>	<p>This string ensemble covers fundamental and intermediate orchestra skills including tuning, vibrato, scales, third and second positions. <p><b>Spanish 1A</b></p> <p>JFL800A</p> <p>1 Year</p>	<p>This course is a study of the skills necessary to gain a background in the Spanish language. The major topics covered will include speaking, oral comprehension, reading, writing, grammar and spelling. The course will also feature a study of social customs, as well as the historical background of the Spanish speaking countries.</p> <p><a href="#">Spanish 1 A Video</a></p>
<p><b>A Hour Co-Ed Physical Education</b></p> <p>1 Year</p>	<p>This course is a study in physical literacy. Physical literacy is the ability to move with competence and confidence in a wide variety of physical activities in multiple environments that benefit the healthy development of the whole person.
