CONTINUING TO GROW

ACCELERATED K-6 CLASSROOMS

K-6 Accelerated classroom learning experiences are now offered at five of our elementary schools, across the district, to meet the needs of our students and families. A unique opportunity for students with strong academic abilities and a love of learning to be challenged in a supported learning environment. Accelerated includes highly-qualified Gilbert Public Schools teachers in every classroom, a well-established GPS curriculum, and enriched project-based learning experiences that support students to thrive. All five schools also offer conventional classrooms, making them the perfect destination for our families, where families can find a learning experience that meets the needs of their children.

PERFORMANCE ACADEMY

For the 2022/23 school year our Performance Academy is growing! Designed for 4th - 8th grade athletes and performing arts students, the program helps students excel academically in a school environment in the mornings and access training and programs in the afternoons, taking their achievements to the next level. Students access academic excellence at Mesquite Elementary and South Valley Junior High in the morning, and attend training or performing arts facility in the afternoons. Performance Academy students have the option to be part of the Legacy Sports USA Sports Enrichment Program at Bell Bank Park.

GILBERT ACCELERATED MIDDLE SCHOOL

Starting in the 2022/23 school year students can choose Gilbert Accelerated Middle School for 7th and 8th grade. Students are immersed in honors and accelerated curriculum with access to the resources of a comprehensive high school, while in a supportive cohort of other 7th and 8th-grade students. The learning experience is both academically rigorous and well-rounded, based on the application of knowledge and reflection, project-based learning, critical thinking, cross-curricular portfolio building, and student-centered learning approaches. Students gain access to the instructional expertise of high school/college-level faculty and are encouraged and supported to develop strong leadership and study skills, preparing them for a successful future.


