




- First bell (warning bell) 8:35am, in the door by 8:40am
- Dismissal bell rings at 3:30pm/2:30pm on Early Wednesdays
- Each class period is 55 minutes/Passing period are 4 minutes
- Lunch (two lunches): 30 minutes
- Students will have 6 class periods
- 7th grade: Core classes, PE and one elective
- 8th grade students will have Core classes & 2 electives
- Advisory Period (AP): 26 minute class period after lunch (M/T/Th/F) to use for academic support and school climate activities

















## CHROMEBOOKS

• Students will take their Chromebook home each night and bring it back to school each day with a full battery charge.


• Device Protection Plans (insurance) available \$25.00 / Students will use their issued CB for (3) years.



- Students must earn a D to pass the class


















- Students in ALP at the elementary school will <u>automatically</u> be placed in honors courses
- Students NOT currently enrolled in ALP but are achieving A's in the on level courses will be <u>automatically</u> placed in honors courses
- Honors Placement depends on:
- State testing scores
- Grades of "A's/B's" during 6th grade
- 6th grade teacher approval
- Strong work ethic, motivation, grasps concepts quickly, willing to seek outside assistance



- PE is required for all incoming 7th graders!
- You have PE <u>everyday!</u>
- You will have a PE locker with a lock. If you lose your lock it will cost \$5.00 to replace it.
- You are required to dress out everyday! PE uniforms are \$20.00 dollars.










- Infinite Campus portal open from 2/8-2/15




